



Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors.
(because prices can vary)

ATTENDED FUNERAL *(funeral director's charge only)*

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

-Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£830
-Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises into the funeral director's care.	£250
-Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at our funeral director's Branch premises.	£100
-Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from an Oak veneered.	£270
-Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director during office hours (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£0
-At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£300

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

-Burial <i>(funeral director's charges only)</i>	£1,000
-Cremation <i>(funeral director's charges, and the cremation fee) *2</i>	£1,295

FEES YOU MUST PAY

-For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee *1	£751-£945
<i>In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: £751 For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</i>	
-For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee. *2	£645-£999
<i>In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is: £999</i>

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

-Additional mileage (price per mile)	£1.50
-Additional staff when required for health and safety purposes. per person	£45
-Additional transfers of the deceased (e.g to their home, to a place of worship etc.) per transfer.	£150
-Collection of ashes, to be collected by client from our premises.	£0
-Embalming (Hygienic treatment)	£150
-Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.)	£200-£250
-Services supplied outside of normal office hours	price on request

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier

*1 : This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

*2 : In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation
